

HILLSBORO HAWKS BAND BOOSTER CLUB
March 19, 2007

The meeting was called to order by Gary Naggi, with eleven (11) members in attendance at 7:00 p.m.

Upcoming events were discussed. The Band Banquet is tentatively scheduled for April 21, 2007 at 7 p.m. with the location still yet unknown. The possibility of holding it in the Viking Room at Jefferson College was discussed and that location was going to be checked on for that date and time. It was decided that the fee would be \$10.00 per person with the senior students eating free.

The Jazz Dinner night, May 12, 2007, was also discussed. It was decided that tickets would be pre-sold with RSVPs being directed to Debbie Naggi at her home phone number.

Discussion was had with regard to the last meeting date being rescheduled at the last moment and the election of Dana Bischoff at President-Elect to replace David Burris. It was explained that there were items that needed to be handled at that point and time so a meeting was held even though school was not in session and the election of Dana Bischoff was to simply get paperwork signed in order to finalize the incorporation of the Boosters and the tax exempt status.

It was decided that in order to efficiently handle future meetings, the Executive Committee would meet two weeks prior to any regularly scheduled meeting to come up with an agenda for that regularly scheduled meeting. Motion was made by Terry Stephens to try this and scheduled the next Executive Committee Meeting for Tuesday, March 27, 2007 at 6 p.m. Motion was seconded by Margie Burris and passed.

While discussing this topic, all future regular meetings were looked at to see if they might possibly conflict with other events and it was found that the May 8th meeting would need to be rescheduled due to the Junior High Band concert. Motion was made by Gary Naggi to move the May meeting to May 1, 2007; seconded by Dana Bischoff and passed.

Bingo and pull tabs were brought up as an idea for future fund raisers. These have been very successful at other schools, but we would need to see if it could be done here. Eva Christ was to approach Jack Stewart, the school district attorney, with this idea and report back at a later meeting.

MOTION was made to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 p.m. by Eva Christ; seconded by Terry Stephens and passed.
