The next order of business was to elect new officers for the upcoming 2007-2008 year.

Shelby Callahan was nominated as historian by Dana Bischoff and she agreed to accept the position. Motion was seconded by Martha Stephens and passed.

Shelby Callahan was also nominated to serve as treasurer for this year by Eva Christ. She also agreed to serve the band boosters in this capacity and motion was seconded by Dana Bischof, and passed.

Eva Christ was nominated to serve as secretary for another year by Martha Stephens. She accepted this nomination. Motion was seconded by Dana Bischoff and passed.

Terry Stephens was nominated for the position of vice-president by Dana Bischoff. He accepted this nomination; motion was seconded by Shelby Callahan and passed.

It was announced to all new members attending the meeting that with the small current number of members of band boosters it had been decided at the June meeting that the office of President-Elect would be removed and the Bylaws of the Boosters had been changed accordingly. As such, no nomination for President-Elect was made.

Dana Bischoff was nominated for the position of president by Eva Christ. She agreed to accept this nomination and serve as this year's president. The motion was seconded by Shelby Callahan and passed.

Eva Christ announced that there was a small problem with our tax exempt filing in that she had learned that the band boosters organization had been incorporated with the Missouri Secretary of State under the incorrect name of HILLSBORO HIGH SCHOOL BAND BOOSTER CLUB and we had been using the name HILLSBORO HAWKS BAND BOOSTER CLUB. She suggested that we amend our Articles of Incorporation with the new name so that we can proceed with obtaining our tax exempt letter. Motion was made by Eva Christ, seconded by Shelby Callahan and passed.

The next order of business was fund raising ideas for the upcoming year. Shelby Callahan suggested that we locate a place to hold a monthly car wash. She had had a lot of success with car washes in the past. Sherri Crow announced that she would be donating four quilts to be raffled or auctioned off at various events, i.e., band concerts, jazz dinner night, etc. Debbie Urban suggested doing a trivia night and volunteered to spearhead that endeavor. Another idea was that the band boosters hold a barbeque where local businesses would be presented with a menu, order from that menu and then the food would be delivered to the business during lunch hours. One other idea is to obtain corporate sponsorship from local businesses. Dana Bischoff and Shelby Callahan were going to work together to come up with a letter to the businesses and information on what they would receive in return for their sponsorship. All of these ideas were tabled to be discussed at our next meeting of September 11, 2007.

With there being no further new business to discuss, Eva Christ made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 p.m., seconded by Terry Stephens and passed.
