(what time the kids need to be at school, what time we leave, when we will eat, etc.)</p> <p>Sally to compile list of background checked parents.</p>

Afghan raffles	<p>We have 2 blue and white afghans that we can raffle.</p> <p>Will sell raffle tickets at next two home football games and will draw winner at last home game for 1 afghan.</p> <p>Will have announced at the games.</p> <p>2<sup>nd</sup> afghan will be raffled at the Christmas concert. Will sell tickets during basketball games.</p>	<p>Alice checked with Mr. Moreno on selling the tickets and he requested an email be sent to him.</p> <p>To have it announced we just need to write the information down and give it to the announcer.</p>
Band Trip 2010	<p>Scheduled for May 13, 14, 15 and 16. Performing is Jazz, Symphonic and maybe Concert Band.</p> <p>Going to Sandusky, Ohio to Cedar Point. Will have 2 days at park. Staying at the Great Wolf Lodge.</p> <p>The approximate cost of the trip for students will be \$402 which includes transportation.</p> <p>The approximate cost for adults <b><u>with no transportation</u></b> is \$244 with 4 people per room or \$309 with 2 people per room.</p>	

	<p>The boosters would like to try to contribute approximately \$100-\$110 per student towards the trip.</p> <p>Free breakfast and possibly 1 free lunch at the park. Students will need money for all other meals.</p>
